



## **B level referees course**

### Course objective

#### Referee understands:-

- Marking (including written scoring systems)
- Standard Calls
- Lets
- Timing
- Player Safety
- Injuries
- Role of referee and marker
- Penalties
- Handling appeals

Referee is accredited to referee matches in A tournaments or in league A

### Course format:-

- Presentation (theory)
- Practical instruction
- Video test on let situations

### Course duration:-

4 hours (2 hours theory, 1 hour practical, 1 hour test and answers)

### Course material provided to participants:-

- Referees line of thinking chart for rule 12
- Flowchart for referees decisions under rule 16
- Recommended responses to appeals
- Full squash rules

### Course requirements:-

- Room for presentation, with chairs, tables, VCR and television
- 1 squash court for 1 hour

Course fees:-

Course pre-requisites:-  
C level referees accreditation or equivalent  
Successful C level assessment or equivalent  
No restriction on repeating the course  
(Players of A or B level may apply for a dispensation from holding the level C accreditation)

To obtain the B level referees accreditation, participants who have successfully completed this course must pass two assessments at official matches between players of B ranking or higher. At least one of these assessments must be carried out by an assessor other than the presenter of this course.

The B level referees accreditation is valid for 3 years, and may be renewed with one further assessment plus evidence of regular refereeing activity at a suitable level.
