



C level referees course

Course objective

Referee understands:-

- Marking (including written scoring systems)
- Standard Calls
- Lets
- Timing
- Player Safety

Referee is accredited to referee matches in B tournaments or in league 1

Course format:-

- Presentation (theory)
- Practical instruction
- Video test on let situations

Course duration:-

3 hours (1.25 hours theory, 0.75 hour practical, 1 hour test and answers)

Course material provided to participants:-

- Written test on the rules of squash
- Standard calls
- Sample scoresheet
- Line of thinking chart for rule 12
- Injury chart

Course requirements:-

- Room for presentation, with chairs, tables, VCR and television, whiteboard
- 1 squash court for 45 minutes

Recommended number of participants:-

12

Course to be given by:-

Squash Romandie accredited refereeing presenter

Course fees:-

SF 20.00 per participant, to be paid to Squash Romandie by the host club

Course pre-requisites:-

Complete a written test on the rules of squash

No restriction on repeating the course

To obtain the C level referees accreditation, participants who have successfully completed this course must pass an assessment on an official match between licenced players. (the course presenter may, at his discretion, determine that this is not necessary for certain candidates)

The C level referees accreditation is valid as long as the referee holds a Squash Romandie players licence. Otherwise the accreditation is valid for 3 years, and may be renewed with one further assessment plus evidence of regular refereeing activity at a suitable level.
