



Referee assessors course

Course objective

Assessor understands:-

- Objectives of an assessment (identifying strengths/weaknesses, assisting the referee to improve)
- How to complete an assessment form
- How to debrief a referee
- What is important at different levels of refereeing

Course format:-

- Presentation (theory)
- Practical instruction
- Exam in simulated situation

Course duration:-

4 hours (2 hours theory, 1 hour practical, 1 hour exam)

Course material provided to participants:-

- Assessment form
- Guidelines to assessors

Course requirements:-

- Room for presentation, with chairs and tables and whiteboard
- 1 squash court for 1.5 hours

Course inscriptions:-

Course pre-requisites:-

- A or B level referees accreditation
- No restriction on repeating the course

The Assessors accreditation is valid for 3 years, and may be renewed with one further assessment plus evidence of regular assessment activity at a suitable level.
